1. Recalcitrant (adjective)

Meaning; Marked by a stubborn unwillingness to obey authority



Synonyms: disobedient, rebellious **Antonyms**: obedient, compliant

2. Skeptic (noun)

Meaning; Someone who habitually doubts beliefs and claims presented as accepted by others



Synonyms: disbeliever Antonyms: believer

3. Reprisal (noun)

Meaning; An act of retaliation.



Synonyms: counterattack Antonyms: remission

4. Abhorrent (Adjective)

Meaning; Contrary to something; discordant.



Synonyms: hateful, repugnant **Antonyms**: delightful, pleasant

5. Conundrum (noun)

Meaning; A difficult question or riddle



Synonyms: dilemma Antonyms: solution

6. Benign (adjective) Meaning; Kind; gentle



Synonyms: gentle Antonyms: unkind
