

VOCABULARY

Fuelled (verb) 1.

Meaning; To exacerbate, to cause to grow or become greater.



Synonyms: encourage, boost **Antonyms:** reduce, moderate

2. Dispel (verb)

Meaning; To drive away or cause to vanish by scattering.



Synonyms: dismiss, eliminate Antonyms: trigger, intensify

3. Pillage (verb)

Meaning; To loot or plunder by force



Synonyms: ransack, ravage **Antonyms:** protect, defend

4. Flout (verb)

Meaning; To express contempt for (laws, rules, etc.) by word or action.





Synonyms: defy, disregard **Antonyms:** honour, respect

Alacritous (adjective) 5.

Meaning; Brisk, speedy, with alacrity, quick and eager.



Synonyms: fast, speedy **Antonyms:** slow, lag

Hoary (adjective) 6.

Meaning; Old or old-fashioned.



Synonyms: old, ancient **Antonyms:** new, modern

Dormant (adjective) 7.

Meaning; Inactive, sleeping, asleep, suspended.



Synonyms: sleeping, slumbering

Antonyms: awake, active
