1. Dole (noun)

Meaning; Money or other goods given as charity.



Synonyms: charity **Antonyms**: forfeit

Noxious (adjective) 2.

Meaning; Harmful; injurious.



Synonyms: harmful, bad **Antonyms:** useful, helpful

Excoriate (verb) 3.

Meaning; To strongly denounce or censure.



Synonyms: criticise, assail **Antonyms**: praise, applaud

4. Augury (noun)

Meaning; An omen or prediction; a foreboding



Synonyms: sign, warning

Antonyms: ignorance, disregard

5. Dotard (noun)

Meaning; An old person with impaired intellect



Synonyms: old, elder

Antonyms: youth, younger

6. Levy (verb)

Meaning; To impose (a tax or fine) to collect monies due



Synonyms: impose, charge Antonyms: concession, cut

7. Steep (adjective)

Meaning; Of a near-vertical gradient; of a slope, surface, curve, etc.



Synonyms: sudden, rapid Antonyms: slow, gradual
