1. Dissuade (verb)

Meaning; To convince not to try or do.



Synonyms: derail, diverge Antonyms: straight, stable

2. Adjudicate (verb)

Meaning; To settle a legal case or other dispute.



Synonyms: arbitrate, decide Antonyms: neglect, ignore

Punctilious (adjective) 3.

Meaning; Strictly attentive to detail



Synonyms: careful, attentive Antonyms: careless, inattentive

Fleece (verb) 4.

Meaning; To con or trick (someone) out of money.



Synonyms: cheat, occupy Antonyms: grant, offer

Boulder (noun) 5.

Meaning; A large mass of stone



Synonyms: stone Antonyms: sand

Arraign (verb) 6.

Meaning; To officially charge someone in a court of law.



Synonyms: accuse, book **Antonyms**: defend, forgive

Venerate (verb) 7.

Meaning; To treat with great respect and deference.



Synonyms: respect, worship **Antonyms**: disrespect, despise
