

VOCABULARY

1. Recalcitrant (adjective)

Meaning; Marked by a stubborn unwillingness to obey authority



Synonyms: disobedient, rebellious Antonyms: obedient, compliant

2. Inchoate (adjective)

Meaning; Recently started but not fully formed yet; just begun



Synonyms: nascent, budding

Antonyms: old, evolved

3. Anonymity (noun)

Meaning; The quality or state of being anonymous; anonymousness.



Synonyms: mystery, unidentified Antonyms: known, identified

4. Hiatus (noun)

Meaning; An interruption, break or pause.



Synonyms: pause, break Antonyms: closure, end

5. Inadvertent (adjective)

Meaning; Not intentional; not on purpose; not conscious.



Synonyms: reckless, careless **Antonyms**: cautious, careful

Meaning; To scruple or object; to take exception; to oppose



Synonyms: object Antonyms: confirm

7. Winsome (adjective)

Meaning; Charming, engaging, winning; inspiring approval and trust



Synonyms: appealing, attractive **Antonyms**: repulsive, unattractive
