

# VOCABULARY

#### 1. Vociferously (adverb)

Meaning; In a vociferous manner.



**Synonyms:** vigorously, strongly **Antonyms:** Effortlessly, easily

# 2. Seclusion (noun)

**Meaning**; The act of secluding, shutting out or keeping apart.



**Antonyms:** public, togetherness **Synonyms:** loneliness, remoteness

## 3. Dissuasive(adjective)

Meaning; Tending to dissuade, or divert from a measure or purpose



Antonyms: stable, track Synonyms: derail, distract

## 4. Relinquish(verb)

Meaning; To give up, abandon or retire from something



Synonyms: renounce Antonyms: retain

 Unruly (adjective) Meaning; Wild; uncontrolled



**Synonyms**: uncontrollable, wild **Antonyms**: controllable, obedient

6. Surmise (verb)

Meaning; Thought, imagination



**Synonyms**: suppose, think **Antonyms**: sense, recognise

7. Bout (noun)

Meaning; A period of something, usually painful or unpleasant



**Synonyms:** stretch, spell **Antonyms:** stagnation, stop
