

# **VOCABULARY**

## Deplore (verb) 1.

Meaning; To bewail; to weep bitterly over; to feel sorrow for.



Synonyms: lament, complain

**Antonyms**: commend, compliment

# 2. Abort (verb)

Meaning; To stop or fail at something in the preliminary stages.



Synonyms: halt, stop

Antonyms: begin, continue

### Rubric (noun) 3.

**Meaning**; An established rule or custom; a guideline



Synonyms: course **Antonyms**: disperse

#### 4. Fret(verb)

**Meaning**; To be anxious, to worry.



**Synonyms:** bother **Antonyms:** comfort

## 5. Traverse (verb)

**Meaning**; To travel across, often under difficult conditions.



Synonyms: span, cross Antonyms: hold, confine

# Oversight (noun) 6.

Meaning; An omission; something that is left out, missed or forgotten.



Synonyms; failure, lapse Antonyms; careful, attention

# 7. Kudos(noun)

Meaning; Praise; accolades.



Synonyms: praise, applaud **Antonyms:** dishonor, criticise
