#### 1.Inglorious (adjective)

Meaning; Ignominious; disgraceful



**Synonyms:** disgraceful, shameful **Antonyms:** respectful, appreciable

### 2.Churlishness (noun)

Meaning; the state of being rude, surly



**Synonyms**: rancor, antagonism **Antonyms**: love, kindness

### **3.Exculpatory (adjective)**

Meaning; tending to excuse or clear of wrongdoing.



**Synonyms**: defensible, pardonable **Antonyms**: unforgivable, inexcusable


## **4.Tortuous (adjective) Meaning**; Twisted; having many turns



**Synonyms**: curvy, winding **Antonyms**: direct, straight

## 5.Distil (verb)

Meaning; To extract the essence of; concentrate; purify.



**Synonyms**: extract, squeeze **Antonyms**: conceal, hide

### **6.Convene (verb)**

**Meaning**; To come together; to meet; to unite.



**Synonyms**: summon, hold **Antonyms**: scatter, disseminate

**7.Dither (verb) Meaning**; To be uncertain or unable to make a decision



**Synonyms**: hesitate, falter **Antonyms**: certain, sure
