1. **Trepidation (noun)**

**Meaning;** A fearful state; a state of concern or hesitation.



**Synonyms:** fear, apprehension

**Antonyms:** delight, bravery

2. **Furtive (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Exhibiting guilty or evasive secrecy.



**Synonyms:** fraud

**Antonyms:** reliable

3. **Obstreperous (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Attended by, or making, a loud and tumultuous noise; boisterous.



**Synonyms:** blusterous

**Antonyms:** calm

4. **Laureate (noun)**

**Meaning;** One crowned with laurel/honour



**Synonyms:** victor

**Antonyms:** loser

5. **Petulant (adjective)**

**Meaning;** childishly irritable



**Synonyms:** irritable, cranky

**Antonyms:** cheerful, delightful

6. **Distract(adjective)**

**Meaning;** absent-minded, troubled, distracted

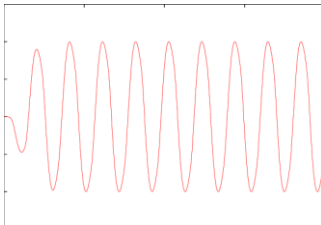


**Synonyms:** inattentive, careless

**Antonyms:** attentive, careful

7. **Vacillate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To sway unsteadily from one side to the other; oscillate.



**Synonyms:** oscillate

**Antonyms:** resolute
