1. Irascible (adjective)

Meaning; Easily provoked to outbursts of anger; irritable.

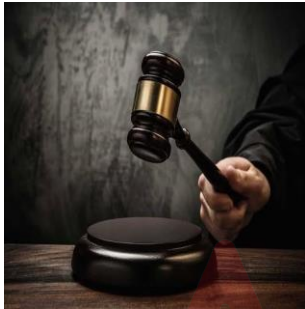


Synonyms: irritable, short-tempered

Antonyms: cheerful, delightful

2. Inviolable (adjective)

Meaning; Not violable; not to be infringed.



Synonyms: unbreakable

Antonyms: breakable

3. Abhorrent (Adjective)

Meaning; Contrary to something; discordant.

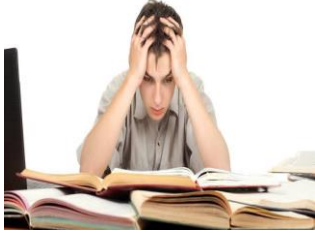


Synonyms: hateful, repugnant

Antonyms: delightful, pleasant

4. **Humdrum (adjective)**

Meaning; Lacking variety or excitement; dull; boring.



Synonyms: boring, dull

Antonyms: exciting, pleasing

5. **Ardent (adjective)**

Meaning; Full of ardor; fervent, passionate.



Synonyms: enthusiastic, excited

Antonyms: dull, apathetic

6. **Mayhem (noun)**

Meaning; A state or situation of great confusion, disorder, trouble or destruction; chaos.



Synonyms: disorder, Chaos

Antonyms: peace, stability

7. **Intrigue (verb)**

Meaning; A complicated or clandestine plot



Synonyms: conspire

Antonyms: expose
