Synonyms: topple, overturn **Antonyms:** rectify, resolve

2. Cascade (noun)

Meaning; A stream or sequence of a thing or things



Synonyms: group, lot Antonyms: sole, lone


Meaning; A criticism or uncomplimentary remark



Synonyms: affront, condemn Antonyms: commendation, compliment

Meaning; Not similar or congruent; not matching or fitting in.



Synonyms: unsuitable, contrary **Antonyms:** suitable, appropriate

 Astute (adjective) Meaning; Shrewd or crafty.



Synonyms: crafty, canny **Antonyms:** inept, foolish

6. Beguile (verb) Meaning; To deceive



Synonyms: betray, deceive **Antonyms**: aid, confirm
