Meaning; To invade; to encroach



Synonyms: encroach, infringe

Antonyms: leave, free

2. Brace(verb)

Meaning; To prepare for something bad, such as an impact or blow.



Antonyms: drain

3. Bungler (noun)


Meaning; Someone who makes mistakes because of incompetence.



Synonyms: inept **Antonyms**: expert

Vilify (verb) 4.

Meaning; To say defamatory things about someone or something; to speak ill of.



Synonyms: defame **Antonyms**: commend

Trammel (noun) 5.

Meaning; Whatever impedes activity, progress



Synonyms: constraint, impediment

Antonyms: aid, assist

6. Eschew (verb)

Meaning; To avoid; to shun



Synonyms: abandon Antonyms: accept

7. Equanimity (noun)

Meaning; the state of being calm, stable



Synonyms: cool, peaceful

Antonyms: agitation, disturbance
