**Meaning;** To campaign.



**Synonyms:** offer, propose

**Antonyms:** neglect, ignore

2. **Prudent (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Practically wise, judicious, shrewd



**Synonyms:** judicious, wise

**Antonyms:** incautious, unwise

3. **Imbue (verb)**

**Meaning;** To wet or stain an object completely with some physical quality.



**Synonyms:** permeate

**Antonyms:** drain

**4. Append(verb)**

**Meaning;** To add, as an accessory to the principal thing; to annex



**Synonyms:** adjoin, attach

**Antonyms:** exclude, remove

**5. Peter (verb)**

**Meaning;** To dwindle



**Synonyms:** decline, lessen

**Antonyms:** increase, enhance

**6. Comport(verb)**

**Meaning;** To be in agreement



**Synonyms:** fit, cohere

**Antonyms:** conflict, disagreement

**7. Menace (verb)**

**Meaning;** A perceived threat or danger



**Synonyms:** endanger
