

1. **Precarity (noun)**

**Meaning;** condition of existence without predictability



**Synonyms:** unpredictability, uncertainty

**Antonyms:** predictability, certainty

2. **Fragile (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Easily broken or destroyed



**Synonyms:** feeble, delicate

**Antonyms:** firm, strong

3. **Bare (verb)**

**Meaning;** Naked, uncovered

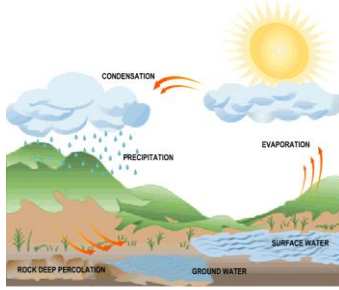


**Synonyms:** expose, uncover

**Antonyms:** cover, hide

4. **Ensue (verb)**

**Meaning;** To occur afterwards, as a result or effect



**Synonyms:** emanate, occur

**Antonyms:** halt, neglect

5. **Stern (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Having a hardness and severity of nature or manner



**Synonyms:** harsh, rigid

**Antonyms:** soft, gentle

6. **Traction (noun)**

**Meaning;** to get attention or to make a progress.
