

1. **Procurement (noun)**

**Meaning;** The act of procuring or obtaining; obtainment



**Synonyms:** attainment

**Antonyms:** renouncement

2. **Staid (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Not capricious or impulsive; sedate, serious, sober.



**Synonyms:** composed, dignified

**Antonyms:** undignified, hilarious

3. **Stretch (verb)**

**Meaning;** To lengthen



**Synonyms:** expand

**Antonyms:** constrain

4. **Sidle (verb)**

**Meaning;** To (cause something to) move sideways.



**Synonyms:** slide

**Antonyms:** stride

5. **Terse (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Of speech or style: brief, concise, to the point.



**Synonyms:** laconic, concise

**Antonyms:** elaborate, verbose

6. **Avaricious (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Actuated by avarice; extremely greedy for wealth or material gain



**Synonyms:** greedy, selfish

**Antonyms:** generous, unselfish

7. **Sordid (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Dirty or squalid.



**Synonyms:** miserable, dirty

**Antonyms:** pleasant, clean
