

VOCABULARY

1. Alacritous (adjective)

Meaning; Brisk, speedy, with alacrity, quick and eager.



Synonyms: fast, speedy **Antonyms:** slow, lag

2. Dormant (adjective)

Meaning; Inactive, sleeping, asleep, suspended.



Synonyms: sleeping, slumbering Antonyms: awake, active

3. Spite (noun)

Meaning; Ill will or hatred toward another



Synonyms: animosity, hate **Antonyms**: kindness, love

4. Flout (verb)

Meaning; To express contempt for (laws, rules, etc.) by word or action



Synonyms: defy, ignore **Antonyms**: abide, follow

5. Pillage (verb)

Meaning; To loot or plunder



Synonyms: ransack, ravage **Antonyms**: protect, conserve

6. Slumbery (Adjective) Meaning; Sleepy, slumberous.



Synonyms: tired, exhausted **Antonyms:** vigilant, attentive

7. Drill (noun)

Meaning; To cause to drill practice; to train in military arts.



Synonyms: command, exercise **Antonyms**: submit, defy
