

1. **Alacritous (adjective)**

Meaning; Brisk, speedy, with alacrity, quick and eager.

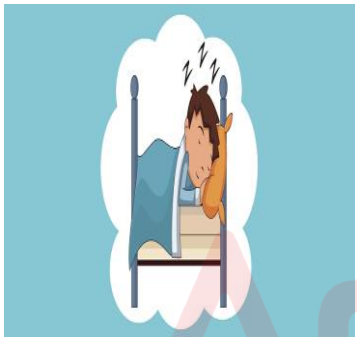


Synonyms: fast, speedy

Antonyms: slow, lag

2. **Dormant (adjective)**

Meaning; Inactive, sleeping, asleep, suspended.



Synonyms: sleeping, slumbering

Antonyms: awake, active

3. **Spite (noun)**

Meaning; Ill will or hatred toward another



Synonyms: animosity, hate

Antonyms: kindness, love

4. **Flout (verb)**

Meaning; To express contempt for (laws, rules, etc.) by word or action



Synonyms: defy, ignore

Antonyms: abide, follow

5. **Pillage (verb)**

Meaning; To loot or plunder



Synonyms: ransack, ravage

Antonyms: protect, conserve

6. **Slumbery (Adjective)**

Meaning; Sleepy, slumberous.



Synonyms: tired, exhausted

Antonyms: vigilant, attentive

7. **Drill (noun)**

Meaning; To cause to drill practice; to train in military arts.



Synonyms: command, exercise

Antonyms: submit, defy
