

1. **Delve (verb)**

**Meaning;** To dig, to excavate, to search deeply



**Synonyms:** probe, examine

**Antonyms:** neglect, ignore

2. **Smidgen (noun)**

**Meaning;** A very small quantity or amount.



**Synonyms:** bit

**Antonyms:** lot

3. **Vandalise (noun)**

**Meaning;** To needlessly destroy or deface public property;



**Synonyms:** destroy, annihilate

**Antonyms:** protect, build

**4. Rant (verb)**

**Meaning;** A criticism done by ranting.



**Synonyms:** yell

**Antonyms:** quiet

**5. Consternation (noun)**

**Meaning;** terror, combined with amazement; dismay



**Synonyms:** anxiety, disturbance

**Antonyms:** satisfaction, comfort

**6. Plea (noun)**

**Meaning;** An appeal, petition, urgent prayer or entreaty.



**Synonyms:** appeal, request

**Antonyms:** order, dictate

**7. Odious (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Arousing or meriting strong dislike



**Synonyms:** repulsive

**Antonyms:** pleasant
