**Meaning;** Intense pleasure.



**Synonyms:** bliss, happiness

**Antonyms:** pain, unhappiness

2. **Mellow (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Relaxed; calm; easygoing; laid-back.



**Synonyms:** melodious, mellifluous

**Antonyms:** harsh, gruff

3. **Intimidate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To make timid or afraid



**Synonyms;** terrify, dishearten

**Antonyms;** please, strengthen

**4. Ruckus (noun)**

**Meaning;** A noisy disturbance and/or commotion.



**Synonyms:** disorder, turbulence

**Antonyms:** tranquil, peace

**5. Surmise (verb)**

**Meaning;** Thought, imagination



**Synonyms:** suppose, think

**Antonyms:** sense, recognise

**6. Relegate(verb)**

**Meaning;** exile, banish, remove, or send away.



**Synonyms:** degrade, downgrade

**Antonyms:** upgrade, promote

**Meaning;** Remarkably bad; of poor quality



**Synonyms:** bad, awful
