

VOCABULARY

1. Arraign (verb)

Meaning; To officially charge someone in a court of law.



Synonyms: accuse, charge

Antonyms: defend, forgive

2. Augury (noun)

Meaning; An omen or prediction; a foreboding



Synonyms: sign, warning

Antonyms: ignorance, disregard

3. Exacerbate (verb)

Meaning; To make worse (a problem, bad situation)



Synonyms: worsen, aggravate

Antonyms: pacify, hold

4. Caucuses (noun)

Meaning; A grouping of all the members of a legislature from the same party.



Synonyms: assembly, gathering

Antonyms: isolation, conformity

5. Vexatious (Adjective)

Meaning; Causing vexation or annoyance; teasing; troublesome.



Synonyms: irksome, annoying

Antonyms: pleasing, aiding

6. Reckon (verb)

Meaning; To count; to enumerate; to number; also, to compute; to calculate.



Synonyms: estimate, consider

Antonyms: refuse, avoid

7. Gloat (verb)

Meaning; To triumph, crow, relish, glory



Synonyms: rejoice, relish

Antonyms: sympathise, unhappy
