**Meaning;** To search thoroughly



**Synonyms:** probe, investigate

**Antonyms:** ignore, hide

2. **Daft (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Foolish, silly, stupid.



**Synonyms:** foolish, insensible

**Antonyms:** clever, sensible

3. **Mettle (adjective)**

**Meaning;** quality of endurance and courage.



**Synonyms:** valour

**Antonyms:** cowardice

4. **Equanimity (noun)**

**Meaning;** the state of being calm, stable



**Synonyms:** cool, peaceful

**Antonyms:** agitation, disturbance

5. **Malaise (noun)**

**Meaning;** A feeling of general bodily discomfort

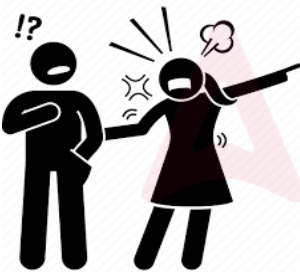


**Synonyms:** Relentless, unease
