1. Delve (verb)

Meaning; To search thoroughly



Synonyms: probe, investigate Antonyms: ignore, hide

2. Daft (adjective)

Meaning; Foolish, silly, stupid.



Synonyms: foolish, insensible Antonyms: clever, sensible

3. Mettle (adjective)

Meaning; quality of endurance and courage.



Synonyms: valour **Antonyms**: cowardice

4. Equanimity (noun)

Meaning; the state of being calm, stable



Synonyms: cool, peaceful

Antonyms: agitation, disturbance

5. Malaise (noun)

Meaning; A feeling of general bodily discomfort



Synonyms: Relentless, unease

Antonyms: relax, comfort

6. Emphatic (adjective)

Meaning; Characterized by emphasis; forceful



Synonyms; firm, forcible

Antonyms; uncertain, doubtful

Meaning; tired or exhausted.
