1. Prudent (Adjective)

Meaning; Practically wise, judicious, shrewd



Synonyms: judicious, Shrewd **Antonyms:** imprudent, unwise

2. Humdrum (adjective)

Meaning; Lacking variety or excitement; dull; boring.



Synonyms: boring **Antonyms**: exciting

3. Brace (verb)

Meaning; To prepare for something bad, such as an impact or blow.



Synonyms: fortify, strengthen Antonyms: reduce, weaken

4. Incense (verb)

Meaning; To anger or infuriate



Synonyms: anger, enrage **Antonyms**: please, calm

5. Ostensibly (noun)

Meaning;



Synonyms: authorisation

Antonyms: denial

6. Slugfest (verb)

Meaning; A game or match in which heavy hits are exchanged



Synonyms: spoil **Antonyms**: leave

7. Solicitor (verb)

Meaning; A person soliciting sales, especially door to door.
