Solutions

S1. Ans.(c)

Sol. The project was funded through the Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF), showcasing a strategic use of public funds for essential infrastructure development.

S2. Ans.(b)

Sol. The market share of electric cars is currently 1.3%, and the objective is to significantly increase this share beyond the current levels.

S3. Ans.(a)

Sol. The undersea cables were laid by the state-owned telecom company BSNL, emphasizing government involvement in critical infrastructure projects.

S4. Ans.(b)

Sol. The "Olympic Consulate" system is designed to streamline the online visa application process for participants in the 2024 Paris Olympics.

S5. Ans.(e)

Sol. A PMI above 50 indicates manufacturing expansion. In this case, 54.9 suggests a continued expansion.

Sol. The lithium reserves in Argentina are primarily concentrated in Catamarca, Salta, and Jujuy provinces.

Sol. The RBI issued the D-SIB framework in 2014, requiring annual disclosure of designated banks starting from 2015.

Sol. Ind-Ra revised India's GDP growth estimate for FY'24 from 6.2% to 6.7%.

Sol. Association of Southeast Asian Nations. ASEAN is a regional intergovernmental organization comprising ten Southeast Asian countries.

Sol. The XPoSat mission is India's first venture into polarimetry, specifically in the field of X-rays, to study celestial sources like black holes.

S12. Ans.(b)

Sol. Ind-Ra's computations suggest that a 1% increase in real wages could potentially lead to a 1.12% growth in real private final consumption expenditure (PFCE) and contribute to a 64 basis point increase in GDP growth.

S13. Ans.(e)

Sol. The upgrade is attributed to PNBHF's improved asset quality and a decrease in credit cost, as highlighted by India Ratings.

S14. Ans.(c)

Sol. The interest rates for the funds raised by SBI are determined as 80 basis points and 100 basis points over the Secured Overnight Financing Rate (SOFR).

S15. Ans.(a)

Sol. Fitch Ratings anticipates a robust 5% GDP growth in India and various emerging markets, as highlighted in their 'APAC Cross-Sector Outlook 2024' report.
