Meaning; Of bad taste; distasteful.



Synonyms: unpleasant, disagreeable

Antonyms: pleasant, satisfying

2. Protracted (adjective)

Meaning; Lasting for a long time or longer than expected or usual.



Synonyms: long, endless

Antonyms: short, brief

Meaning; To speak or protest loudly



Synonyms: boasting, aggressiveness

Antonyms: pacify, calmness

4. Erstwhile (Adjective)

Meaning; Formerly; in the past.



Synonyms: former, past

Antonyms: contemporary, ongoing

5. Laud(verb)

Meaning; Praise or glorification



Synonyms: hail, commend **Antonyms:** criticise, denounce

6. Proffer (verb)

Meaning; To offer for acceptance; to propose to give; to make a tender of



Synonyms: propose, offer **Antonyms**: reject, deny

7. Attune (verb)

Meaning; to bring into harmony or accord.



Synonyms: harmonize, acclimatize Antonyms: disharnonize, destabilise
