1. Leverage (noun)

Meaning; By extension, any influence which is compounded or used to gain an advantage.



Synonyms: influence, dominance **Antonyms:** impotence, powerlessness

2. Exhort (verb)

Meaning; To urge; to advise earnestly



Synonyms: adjure Antonyms: discourage

Hurl (verb) 3.

Meaning; To throw



Synonyms: cast, toss **Antonyms**: catch, hold

4. Tranquility (noun)

Meaning; the state of being tranquil, the absence of disturbance; peacefulness



Synonyms: calmness **Antonyms:** chaos

5. Vanquish (verb)

Meaning; To defeat, to overcome



Synonyms: defeat, conquer Antonyms: surrender, lose

6. **Encrust (verb)**

Meaning; To cover with a hard crust.



Synonyms: cover, hide Antonyms: reveal, strip

7. Perfunctory (adjective)

Meaning; Done only to fulfil a duty, or in a careless manner



Synonyms: careless, inattentive **Antonyms**: carefull, attentive
