#### **Solutions**

#### S1. Ans.(a)

Sol. India Ratings forecasts a GDP growth rate of 6.5% for FY25, slightly below the Reserve Bank of India's estimate of 7.0%.

#### S2. Ans.(c)

Sol. India Ratings forecasts headline retail inflation at 4.8% for FY25, slightly higher than the Reserve Bank of India's projection. This indicates a moderate increase in consumer prices, potentially influenced by various economic factors such as global commodity prices and consumption patterns.

S3. Ans.(e)

Sol. The Ministry of Mines reported a 5.1% increase in mineral output in December 2023 compared to the same period in 2022. This signifies significant growth in the mining and quarrying sector during this time frame.

S4. Ans.(b)

Sol. The composite PMI for India in February 2024, which reached a 7-month high according to the report. This indicates strong performance in both manufacturing and services sectors.

S5. Ans.(b)

Sol. The report's finding that private sector job creation in India halted in February 2024, marking the end of a 20-month streak of continuous job growth.

S6. Ans.(d)

Sol. ADB, founded in 1966, functions as a financial institution aimed at economic development in the Asia-Pacific region. Owned by 68 members, including 49 from the region, the bank plays a crucial role in fostering economic growth and cooperation in the region.

S7. Ans.(a)

Sol. HSBC's India operations yielded a profit of \$1.5 billion in 2023, marking a significant increase from \$1.2 billion in the previous year.

S8. Ans.(e)

Sol. ADB has approved a USD 23 million loan to enhance access to quality fintech education, research, and innovation at the Gujarat International Finance Tec-City (GIFT) in India.

S9. Ans.(c)

Sol. Prime Minister Modi laid the foundation stone for the Shri Kalki Dham Temple in Sambhal, Uttar Pradesh, as part of a ceremonial event.

S10. Ans.(d)

Sol. According to the NCRB data provided, Madhya Pradesh reported the highest number of missing women and girls.

S11. Ans.(c)

Sol. FCI operates under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Government of India.

S12. Ans.(b)

Sol. The Government of India has decided to extend its flagship scheme for women safety until 2025-26, with an allocated budget of Rs 1,179.72 crore. This decision comes in response to the alarming rate of crimes against women in the country, as highlighted by recent statistics from the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB).

Sol. The Ministry of AYUSH, along with the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, announced a joint initiative aimed at improving the health of tribal students in Eklavya Model Residential Schools. This initiative focuses on implementing Ayurvedic interventions to address the health needs of over 20,000 tribal students.

Sol. Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan inaugurated the Rashtriya Udyamita Vikas Pariyojana in Sambalpur, Odisha. Aimed at PM SVANidhi beneficiaries, the initiative focuses on entrepreneurship training, reskilling, and upskilling. Partnerships with Flipkart and expert involvement ensure effective implementation, fostering a culture of entrepreneurship nationwide. The initiative aims to ensure 40% participation by women, highlighting the focus on gender inclusivity and empowerment in entrepreneurship.
