Get over: to return to your usual state of health, happiness after a shock.
Hence 'to get over' should be used.

Sol. Make over: transform. Add 'had' before 'made' as the sentence demands the usage of 'Past Perfect Tense' here.

S3. Ans.(b)

Sol. Replace 'larger' by 'largest'. Article 'the' takes 'superlative degree of adjective' after it not the 'comparative degree'.

S4. Ans.(b)

Sol. Use preposition 'by' with 'baffled'.

S5. Ans.(b)

Sol. Replace 'are' with 'is'. 'Romanticism of melancholy' is a singular subject and hence should be followed by a singular verb.

Sol. Replace 'are' by 'is'. A series of /A band of/ A bunch of etc. + Plural Noun take singular verb with it.

Sol. Replace 'with' by 'on' or 'over' because with "keep watch", on/over is used.

Sol. Replace 'who' with 'that'. Relative pronoun 'who' is used for living things hence doesn't fit in the context.

Sol. Replace 'resident' with 'residence'.


Resident: a person who lives somewhere permanently or on a long-term basis.

Residence: the place where someone lives.

In the given sentence, reference of a place is given. Hence use 'residence' in place of 'resident'.
