- (c) the number of new employees recruited on regular basis in the past five years in each division, year-wise;
- (d) the number of posts abolished during five years; and
- (e) the number of contractual, temporary and outsourced employees in Indian railways including housekeeping and production units as on date?

(a) & (b) : The details of sanctioned strength (SS), On-roll (OR) and vacancies (VAC), category-wise on Indian Railways as on 01.07.2023 is appended as Appendix-I.

(c) : The details of candidates empanelled against various Group 'C' posts excluding Level-1 by 21 Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs) during last five years are appended as Appendix-II.

Zone-wise detail of candidates empanelled for Group 'C' posts in Railway Protection Force (RPF) / Railway Protection Special Force (RPSF) in the last five years are appended as Appendix-III.

Zone-wise details of candidates empanelled in Level-1 (erstwhile Group'D') in last five years are appended as Appendix-IV.

Recruitment to Group 'A' services in Indian Railways is done on all India basis. The details of recruitment made in Group 'A' services on Indian Railways are appended as Appendix-V.

(d) : Rationalization of posts is periodically done based on manpower requirement. Manpower planning requires continuous review of sanctioned strength in view of changing workload conditions, introduction of new technologies, working systems, creation of new assets etc. Work studies are regularly conducted for rationalization of manpower in Railways for various activities. This exercise enables Indian Railways to utilize its human resources in most efficient and productive manner.

(e) : The number of temporarily engaged personnel in Indian Railways in 2023-2024 (upto 30.07.2023) is 7870*.
