1. **Abhorrent (Adjective)**

Meaning; Contrary to something; discordant.



Synonyms: hateful, repugnant

Antonyms: delightful, pleasant

2. **Pander (verb)**

Meaning; An illicit or illegal offer, usually to tempt.

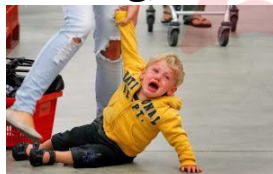


Synonyms: gratify, satisfy

Antonyms: dissatisfy, deny

3. **Petulant (adjective)**

Meaning; childishly irritable



Synonyms: grouchy, bad-tempered

Antonyms: genial, affable

4. **Humdrum (adjective)**

Meaning; Lacking variety or excitement; dull; boring.



Synonyms: boring, dull

Antonyms: exciting, pleasing

5. Mayhem (noun)

Meaning; A state or situation of great confusion, disorder, trouble or destruction; chaos.



Synonyms: disorder, Chaos

Antonyms: peace, stability

6. Agony (noun)

Meaning; anguish, distress



Synonyms: suffering, pain

Antonyms: pleasure, satisfaction

7. Clamour (noun)

Meaning; A continued public expression, often of dissatisfaction or discontent



Synonyms: protest, outcry

Antonyms: peace, silence

8. Prognosticate(verb)

Meaning; To predict or forecast



Synonyms: predict

Antonyms: ignore
