**Meaning;** To have a discussion



**Synonyms:** discussion, consultation

**Antonyms:** difference, uproar

2. **Sedate (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Remaining composed and dignified, and avoiding too much activity or excitement.



**Synonyms:** calm, composed

**Antonyms:** flustered, agitated

3. **Ignominy (noun)**

**Meaning;** Great dishonor



**Synonyms:** disgrace

**Antonyms:** honor

4. **Slovenly (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Having an untidy appearance; unkempt.



**Synonyms:** messy

**Antonyms:** organised

5. **Derisive (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Expressing or characterized by derision; mocking; ridiculing.



**Synonyms:** scornful

**Antonyms:** respectful

6. **Abstruse (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Difficult to comprehend or understand



**Synonyms:** esoteric, obscure
