

1. **Stint (noun)**

**Meaning;** A period of time spent doing or being something; a spell.



**Synonyms:** duty, job

**Antonyms:** leisure, pastime

2. **Fleece (verb)**

**Meaning;** To con or trick (someone) out of money.



**Synonyms:** cheat, occupy

**Antonyms:** grant, offer

3. **Arraign (verb)**

**Meaning;** To officially charge someone in a court of law.



**Synonyms:** accuse, book

**Antonyms:** defend, forgive

**4. Posturing (noun)**

**Meaning;** The assumption of an exaggerated pose or attitude.



**Synonyms:** display, pretend

**Antonyms:** withhold, real

**5. Venerate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To treat with great respect and deference.



**Synonyms:** respect, worship

**Antonyms:** disrespect, despise

**6. Petulance (verb)**

**Meaning;** Rudeness, insolence



**Synonyms:** cynicism, viciousness

**Antonyms:** politeness, kindness

**7. Farce (noun)**

**Meaning;** A ridiculous or empty show.



**Synonyms:** travesty, charade

**Antonyms:** reverence, sobriety
